Vth EUROPEAN HORTICULTURE CONGRESS (EHC 2024)

The University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine in Bucharest organizes on 12-16 May 2024, the Vth European Horticulture Congress (EHC 2024), under the auspices of the International Society for Horticultural Science (ISHS) and under the patronage of the Romanian Academy.

The European Horticulture Congress - former Symposium of Horticulture in Europe (SHE) is organized every four years, the previous editions hosted by Germany (Stuttgart - 2021), Greece (Chania - 2016), France (Angers - 2012), and Austria (Vienna - 2008).

The venue of the Congress is the Bucharest International Conference Center, within the Parliament Palace and we estimate that over 1,000 scientists will participate at 10 Symposia.



Located in Bucharest, the building is an essential piece of Romanian recent history The Palace of the Parliament was built between 1984 and 1997, and it dominates the city's landscape due to its monumental dimensions.

It is the largest and the heaviest administrative building in the world with 240 meters in length, 270 meters in width, and 84 meters tall. At the same time, it is the world's second-largest after the Pentagon, in terms of area.



Bucharest, a green capital

The city is situated on the banks of the Dâmbovița River, which flows into the Argeș River, a tributary of the Danube.

Bucharest parks and gardens also include Herăstrău Park, Tineretului Park and the Botanical Garden. Herăstrău Park is located in the northern part of the city, around Lake Herăstrău, and includes the site the Village Museum.

Tineretului Park was created in 1965 and designed as the main recreational space for southern Bucharest. The Botanical Garden, located in the Cotroceni neighbourhood a bit west of the city centre, is the largest of its kind in Romania and contains over 10,000 species of plants (many of them exotic); it originated as the pleasure park of the royal family.

Besides them, there are many other smaller parks that should be visited, some of them being still large. Alexandru Ioan Cuza Park, Kiseleff Park, Carol Park, Izvor Park, Grădina Icoanei, Circului Park and Moghioroș Park are a few of them. Other large parks in Bucharest are: National Park, Tei Park, Eroilor Park and Crângași Park with Morii Lake.




